**Description: While I was helping the adult patron, her daughter was playing in the children's toy area. The daughter shouted "mommy." And the adult patron, Ms. Cardenas then went over to her. Ms. Cardenas returned to the front desk and apologized that her child had had a urination accident due to potty training. The patron left to care for her child. I then proceeded to put on gloves, soak up the urine with paper towels and then followed up by spraying the mats where the daughter had urinated with Lysol spray. I also cordoned off the area and since it was the end of day, left after notifying staff and the director.**

**Follow up: The director assisted with the incident by asking Gregory to put caution tape around the area to block it off from usage. Next, the mats were examined and it was determined liquid soaked through the cracks in the mats, that were old, and per public CA Health Code the mats were discarded.
